I really would appreciate your prayers for me physically in ministry. I've discovered my body doesn't bounce back like it used to.

We have been invited back again for our third trip to Ecuador. The raising of financial funds concerning the trip will be left up to me. The cost of the trip per person is \$1700 which includes airfare, transportation, lodging, and meals. I have two requests of you; the first would be that you begin to pray for the high school students, college students, adults and myself attending this trip, for our safety, health, and emotional and spiritual well being.
